Any of the following billing codes will meet compliance for the measure:</p> <ul data-bbox="389 1428 1274 1617" style="list-style-type: none"> • Office visit codes 99211 - 99215 • Psychiatric diagnostic evaluation codes: 90791, 90792 • Psychotherapy codes: 90832 - 90834 • Health and behavior assessment/intervention codes: 96150 - 96154 • Preventive medicine, counseling codes: 99401 - 99404 <p data-bbox="389 1648 1445 1753">The “Children with Pharyngitis 2017 Strep Test“ HEDIS measure will be met by performing and billing a group A streptococcus (strep) test (CPT code 87081) if you are prescribing an antibiotic for streptococcal pharyngitis.</p> <p data-bbox="389 1785 1445 1911"><i>A provider/practitioner is eligible to receive \$100 or more for each attributed patient multiplied by the compliance rate with the measure.
